IADR Kulzer Travel Award 2021 – application phase started

By means of the IADR Kulzer Travel Award the dental company Kulzer enables young scientists to present their research work at the IADR General Session & Exhibition, the world's largest dental congress. Young scientists can now apply for the award 2021.

Hanau, August 24th 2020. Kulzer established the IADR Kulzer Travel Award in 2010 to encourage young scientists to undertake research in innovative testing methods of dental materials and find new ideas and approaches to improve and develop dental materials.

The award covering the travel expenses will allow the winners to attend and to present their research work at the 99th IADR General Session & Exhibition taking place from 21 to 24 July 2021 in Boston, Mass., USA.

Nominated by the independent Scientific Committee of the IADR Dental Materials Group, the award is granted to one researcher from each of the following regions, respectively: North America, Latin America, Europe, Africa/Middle East and Asia/Pacific.

Who can apply for the award? Young researchers (up to five years of post-graduation in the sector of dental, material science, specialty training, or pre-PhD) are eligible to apply for a Travel Award. Persons having already obtained a PhD are not eligible to apply again.
