Kulzer Ltd is making a voluntary modern slavery and human trafficking statement relating to section 54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015.

We oppose slavery and human trafficking in all its forms and make this statement to set out the steps we have taken to ensure that there is no slavery or human trafficking in our business or in our supply chains.

About us

We are a provider of services in the dental sector, providing services exclusively. in the UK. Our annual turnover is under £36 million.

We are a part of the Mitsui Chemicals Group ('the Group'), and our ultimate parent company is Mc Dental Holdings Europe GmbH. Mc Dental Holdings Europe GmbH has its head office in Germany. The Group has over 1,400 employees worldwide, and operates in 27countries.

Although we are not required to make a modern slavery statement under section 54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015, we are making this voluntary statement to show our commitment to ethical trading principles and to set out the steps we are taking to tackle modern slavery and human trafficking in our business and in our supply chains.

Our supply chains are mainly made up of the following:

Our commitment to ethical trading

Due diligence and risk assessment

To help identify and monitor the risk of slavery and human trafficking in our supply chain we vet suppliers and sub-contractors to ensure that they are committed to ethical labour practices and we do not employ contract workers.

To ensure a high level of understanding of the risks of modern slavery and human trafficking in our supply chains and our business, we make our staff aware of the issues.
